ORDINANCE NO. 3290**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TITUSVILLE,
CRAWFORD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA; REPEALING
CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF
THE CITY OF TITUSVILLE, INCLUDING SECTION 705.6 –
SEIZURE AND IMPOUNDING AUTHORIZED, SECTION
705.7 – IMPOUNDING LICENSED DOGS; NOTICE TO
OWNER; REDEMPTION AND DISPOSITION, SECTION 705.8
- IMPOUNDING UNLICENSED DOGS; REDEMPTION AND
DISPOSITION, AND SECTION 705.9 – RECORDS AND
MONTHLY REPORT BY POLICE DEPARTMENT;
PROVIDING SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council (the “Council”) of the City of Titusville, Crawford County, Pennsylvania (the “City”) previously adopted Ordinance 1725 on or about December 22, 1969, as was amended by Ordinance 3092, adopted on or about April 28, 2003, pertaining to the impounding of certain dogs; and

WHEREAS, certain portions of Ordinance 1725, as amended by Ordinance 3092, were codified within Article 705 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Titusville (the “City Code”), specifically as sections 705.6, 705.7, 705.8, and 705.9; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the City no longer engages in the impoundment of dogs, and, as such, the above identified sections of the City Code are no longer required and should be repealed.

NOW THEREFORE, this 4th day of October, 2022, **BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the City Council, Titusville, Crawford County, Pennsylvania, the following:

Section 1. Recitals. That the above recitals are incorporated as if more fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Repealer of Section 705.6. That section 705.6 of the City Code, entitled Seizure and Impounding Authorized, is hereby deleted and repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. Repealer of Section 705.7. That section 705.7 of the City Code, entitled Impounding Licensed Dogs; Notice to Owner; Redemption and Disposition, is hereby deleted and repealed in its entirety.

Section 4. Repealer of Section 705.8. That section 705.8 of the City Code, entitled Impounding Unlicensed Dogs; Redemption and Disposition, is hereby deleted and repealed in its entirety.

Section 5. Repealer of Section 705.9. That section 705.9 of the City Code, entitled Records and Monthly Report by Police Department, is hereby deleted and repealed in its entirety.


Section 6. Repealer of Sections of Ordinance 1725 and Ordinance 3092. That the sections of Ordinance 1725 and Ordinance 3092 that correspond with sections 705.6 through 705.9 of the City Code are also hereby deleted and repealed in their entirety.

Section 7. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the City Council that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after adoption.


